JOSEPH T. MAHONEY received his Ph.D. in Business Economics from the Wharton School of Business of the University of Pennsylvania in 1989. He currently is Associate Professor of Business Administration at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign. His research interest is organizational economics (including the behavioral theory of the firm, transaction costs theory, property rights theory, agency theory, resource-based theory, and an evolutionary/dynamic capabilities theory of the firm). He has published in Academy of Management Review, Antitrust Bulletin, Economic Journal, International Journal of Organization Theory and Behavior, Journal of Agricultural and Resource Economics, Journal of Management, Journal of Management Inquiry, Journal of Management Studies, Managerial and Decision Economics, and Strategic Management Journal. He is a past book review editor of Academy of Management Review and he currently serves on the editorial board of Strategic Management Journal.
